





PROGRESS REPORT ON GERMAN LANGUAGE PROGRAM

SUCCESSFUL LAUNCH OF THE GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSES AT CVTTI

The first batch of the German Language Course launched by CVTTI, with the support of WWCoF, facilitated by Shams Family Foundation USA (SFF) has been awarded certificates upon successful completion of 03 months A-1 course. The course, which was commenced during first week of June 2025. 216 participants were awarded certificates during 1st week of September 2025.



INITIATION OF GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSES

BACKGROUND

CVTTI, with the support of WWCoF, facilitated by Shams Family Foundation USA (SFF) initiated German language courses during June 2025 with a view to help and assist the youth of Gilgit-Baltistan in generating employment opportunities and in pursuing education at renowned educational institutions in Germany. WWCoF, a coalition of philanthropic foundations/NGOs has been working together to strengthen bridges across the world. WWCoF is focused on empowering human potential through education, economic independence, and creating global settlement pathways. Under its "Learn & Earn" platforms, known as Launch Pads, it has provided students with access to affordable education and career-building opportunities in the Global West (Europe & North America). In collaboration with local partners WWCoF has been helping talented and hardworking individuals attain both skill acquisition and job opportunity across various industries.

WWCoF current members include: AASHA Foundation—USA, Education Early to End (EEE)—USA & Pakistan, Education Focused Foundation (EFF) -USA, Hemani Family Foundation (HFF) -USA, and Shams Family Foundation (SFF)---USA. The Shams Family Foundation (SFF) of the Dallas Foundation, Himani Family Foundation, Education Foundation, and AASHA Foundation are non-profit organizations founded by Pakistani Americans. These organizations focus on community welfare and services, with a primary emphasis on education and job assistance.

The key initiatives include; Job Assistance Abroad: These organizations assist Pakistani citizens with technical skills in securing visas for North America and European countries, enabling them to pursue better job opportunities, Education Support: They support students in gaining admissions to degree programs abroad and provide skill development training and programs, and Language diploma Programs: Specifically, they intend to impart language trainings to Pakistani citizens, particularly from Northern Pakistan, to facilitate access to foreign language institutions and enhance job prospects.

Kam Shams, the Lead Partner and Chairman SFF works at the epicenter of Healthcare, Information Technology and Entrepreneurship. His professional experiences include using technology to transform healthcare organizations in USA before he launched his own consulting and software firm 35 years ago, of which he is currently chairman of the board. Since then, The Shams Group has grown and served over 400 healthcare organizations across USA, Canada, Middle East and Asia with a staff of 200 people worldwide.

SFF is an empowerment organization set up as philanthropy organization under the Dallas Foundation. The focus of SFF is empowerment for University Degrees & Vocational Programs in Global West. We







provide opportunities to bring students from countries/communities in crises' to 'countries of opportunities. SSF is currently in partnership with multiple foundation like Aasha, HFF, EFF, EEE in capacity building programs to offer education and job opportunities in Global West.

COLLABORATION WITH GOVERNMENT & NON-GOVERNMENTAL ORGANIZATIONS


While these organizations are making efforts to provide language training and job assistance, it is imperative that relevant government organizations and departments take a more active role in initiating foreign language courses: Conducting foreign language courses, especially German Language Courses at major language institutes and skill development centers across the country, and providing facilities by offering training, lodging, boarding, and accommodation facilities to accommodate a maximum number of students from across the country.

The initiatives of these organizations, in collaboration with government and NGOs support, can lead to enhanced job opportunities: Better job prospects for Pakistani citizens in North America and European countries, increased access to education: More opportunities for students to gain admissions to degree programs abroad, Skill Development-Improved skills and employability of Pakistani citizens through training and diploma programs, and by working together, these organizations and government institutions, and NGOs can create a positive impact on the lives of Pakistani citizens, particularly in the areas of education and employment.

During the last o6 months, CVTTI has conducted a series of meetings with NAVTTC, AKRSP, GBRSP, EDUFOCUS, SAJDA, Ismaili Regional Council, Department of Women D evelopment &Youth Affairs, Department of Parks & Wildlife, Chamber of Commerce & Industry, KADO and other organizations working on gender, social and rural development.

Although, CVTTI could not get any meaningful support including financial support from any of these government or non-governmental organizations during these o6 months and during the conduct of the first batch, however their responses have been found overwhelming and we expect to have stronger linkages, better cooperation and collaboration in





future. This all is happening with the blessings of WWCoF team headed by Sir Kam Shams.

CVVTTI PROGRAM FOR CONDUCTING CERTIFICATE COURSES IN GERMAN LANGUAGE

The CEO CVTTI, while facilitating the visiting dignitaries of the above esteemed organizations during their recent visit to GB, felt it deeply that the unemployed youth and the job seeking young educated students and those who truly wants to pursue higher education and skill development trainings in western advanced and developed countries are required to be guided properly. CVTTI has been trying by its own to impart trainings in languages and had approached NAVTTC to consider its request for initiation of language courses at the institute, sensing the future demands of language courses. However. unfortunately CVTTI could not get trades in languages for imparting such trainings, as NAVTTC language programs are mainly meant for big cities and provincial headquarters and for the northern region NAVTTC emphasizes youth come to Islamabad/ to Rawalpindi. Upon conclusion of the visit of the distinguished members of Shams Family Foundation and other associated welfare organizations to GB and NAVTTC Headquarter Islamabad, CVTTI, with 02 other training



institute in Gilgit-Baltistan, initiated efforts to conduct trainings on self-basis to facilitated the students and job seeking youth from Gilgit-Baltistan.

During May 2025, soon upon conclusion of the visit of distinguished delegates of these organizations, CVTTI conducted a series of meetings with different organizations, relevant government agencies, and drafted proposals for collaborations, technical support and financial assistance from available channels. However, the response from government agencies were not empathic, so we started work on our own and decided to take initiative as the pioneer training institute, as we did in the case of beauty therapy in the past. We published advertisements and started door to door campaigns through different means in order to inform the general public at mass level.



Alhamdullillah! We succeeded in our efforts and the response from youth was overwhelming. Subsequently we started receiving applications and enrollment of aspiring youth in our program. The training started during 1st week of June 2025, and the first batch completed the A-1 course during 1st week of September and were awarded certificates.

Upon completion of first batch A-1 level, we have started A-2 level course for more than 150 students and about 150 students have been enrolled in the A-1 level German Language Course as Batch-2.

CELEBRATION OF INDEPENDENCE DAY AT CAPITAL VOCATIONAL & TECHNICAL TRAINING INSTITUTE

CVTTI celebrated the Independnce Day on 14th August 2025 at the Institute. More than 200 trainees/course participants attended the event enthusiastically. The institute was decorated with national flags, colorful baloons and flowers. The event started with National Anthem and participants sang national songs and folk songs and famous regional language songs to mark the event. The management of the Institute and participants cut cakes and participants were served with tea, cold drinks and snacks.







CERTIFICATE AWARD CEREMONY AND COMMENCEMENT OF A-2 LEVEL GERMAN LANGUAGE COURSE

The first batch of training for A-1 level course was started during 1st week of June 2025. The management received hundreds of applications with unprecedented interest and enthusiasm was shown by our youth. Proper written tests were conducted during 1st week of June 2025 and the first batch completed the A-1 course during 1st week of September and were awarded certificates.







Upon completion of first batch A-1 level, we have started A-2 level course for more than 150 students and about 150 students have been enrolled in the A-1 level German Language Course as Batch-2. Tests have been conducted on the same pattern, which Goethe and other recognized institutions adapts for induction of course participants and for awarding certificates.

We were fortunate to have the services of 02 well learned, experienced and qualified German Instructors namely Mr. Bakht Karam Mian and Mr Muhammad Umair. Our students are highly satisfied and have great admiration for both the learned instructors.



LAUNCH OF ONLINE GERMAN LANUGUAGE COURSES

CVTTI German language Team, comprised of the 02 abled and seasoned Instructors Mr. Bakht Karam Mian and Mr Muhammad Umair have launched the Online German Language Course Program from 1st October 2025

This online program is initially focused on A-1, A-2 and B-1 level classes. With the slogan of Learn Anytime and Anywhere with Our Online Courses, we are hopeful to attract a good number of students and aspirants who wish to learn German Language online because of their work burden or due to other social or financial issues.

These online courses shall have interactive lessons, official syllabus, flexible schedules and on-campus classes as well if students desire to do so.

The two certified and highly professional Instructors Mr. Bakht Karam Mian and Mr Muhammad Umair are planned to deliver 04 classes a day.
